JOHN AKOMFRAH

Ghanian born filmmaker John Akomfrah has been chosen from a shortlist of 6 of the world's most important artists to win the UK's leading prize for international contemporary art, Artes Mundi 7.

Is a two screen film that brings together 8 interconnected mass migrations, which have taken place during the past 400 years beginning with the little known 1654 fleeing of Sephardic Jews from Catholic Brazil to Barbados. It then continues to reveal many more examples of global displacement due to religious persecution throughout history and in the present day for example migrations from Hombori, Mali and Mosul, Iraq.

Visual analysis:

Composition – how has the artist used the camera frame? Why has he chosen to use two screens running simultaneously?

Viewpoint – what is significant about the viewpoint of the characters and the viewer? What varieties of shots have been used?

Sound – Why is sound important in any video art work? What is striking about Auto Da Fé?

Structure - What repeated symbols or patterns can you see in the film? What decisions did the artist make when editing the film?

Colour – how effective is the use of colour in the film? Is there a contrast of light and dark or times of the day?

Key questions:

Location – what is significant about the locations used in the film?

The Sea – why is the sea an important symbol in *Auto Da Fé*?

The people – what are they doing there? How do they feel?

The objects – what belongings would you take with you and why?



After the exhibition:

- Choose one of the words noted in the gallery, write that word on one side of the paper and visually represent it on the other. Arrange all of your responses to create a poem that shows the story of Auto Da Fé. Read the poem aloud in a variety of ways, does it change the mood of the poem?
- Explore and discuss the current refugee crisis. Akomfrah talks about the sea as a 'corridor of uncertainty' in order to flee your country you have to navigate 'death'. Why do families risk death to migrate? What memories does the sea contain from all of these stories throughout history? Can you make an artwork to represent one or some of these stories?

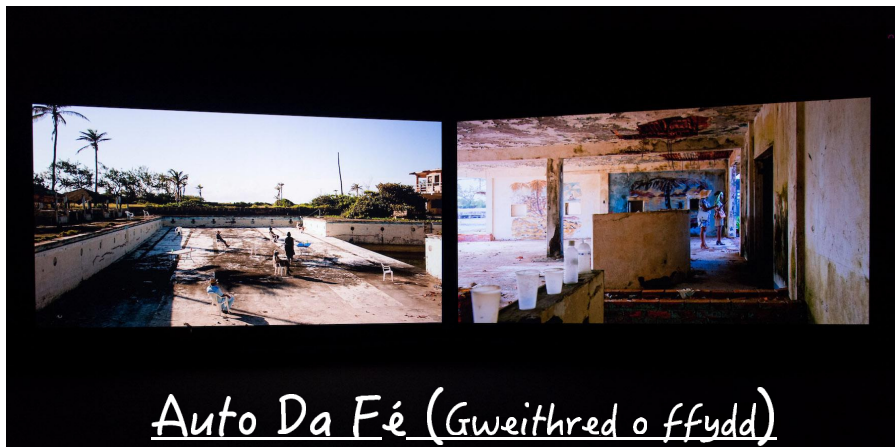

Auto Da Fé (Gweithred o ffydd)



Mae'r gwneuthurydd ffilmiau o Ghana John Akomfrah wedi'i ddewis o restr fer o 6 o artistiaid pwysicaf y byd i ennill prif wobwr y DU am gelfyddyd gyfoes ryngwladol, Artes Mundi 7.

Dyma ffilm sy'n dwyn at ei gilydd 8 ymfudiad torfol rhyng-gysylltiedig sydd wedi digwydd yn ystod y 400 mlynedd diwethaf gan ddechrau gyda hanes gweddol anhysbys yr Iddewon Seffardig yn ffoi o'r Frasil Gatholig i Barbados ym 1654. Yna, mae'n mynd yn ei blaen i ddatgelu llawer mwy o enghreifftiau o ddadleoli byd-eang oherwydd erledigaeth grefyddol drwy hanes ac yn yr oes sydd ohoni, er enghraifft, ymfudo o Hombori ym Mali a Mosul yn Irac.

How did the artist make the film?

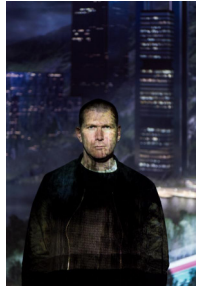

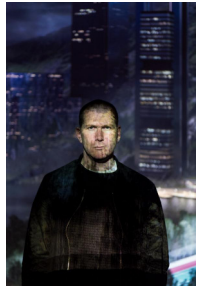

FUTURE FARMERS

Futurefarmers are a group of art and farming practitioners founded in 1995 by California-based artist Amy Franceschini. Their work at Artes Mundi 7 acts as a set of props to explore their journey so far – they have travelled from Oslo on an 1895 rescue boat called the Christiania to meet with farmers and exchange grains and stories. This 'seed journey' explores the preservation of ancient grains and their importance to biodiversity, history and humanity.

Imagine you are going on a long journey, a long way from home.

You can only take 7 items. What would you take and why?

What objects are most important to you?

Do they share a story about you or your family?

Where in the world would you love to visit?

What would you hope to learn about the people there?
