

Engagement Producer Information and Application Pack

Introduction

Artes Mundi is the key internationally focused flagship visual arts organisation in Wales generating unique opportunities for individuals and local communities to engage creatively with the urgent issues of our time in ways which resonate with us all. We are committed to stimulating dialogues and debates, internationally and locally, that develop greater understanding of ourselves, of others, and of the relations between familiar and distant cultures.

In 2023 Artes Mundi will launch AM10, our tenth biennial exhibition and prize, celebrating our 20th anniversary of presenting groundbreaking international contemporary art in Wales. As the first pan-Wales iteration of the project, AM10 will take place across four cities with five venue partners. We are looking to appoint seven Engagement Producers who will work with us develop and deliver new creative routes into the AM10 exhibition. The Engagement Producers will work closely with the exhibition, the Artes Mundi team and each other to develop content for tours, workshops and events that relate to the work in the exhibition. The Role

Each of the seven Engagement Producers will be responsible for delivering a set of events, activities and outcomes as listed below. As a means to identify and structure this aspect of our overall public programming, each Engagement Producer will be assigned to undertake in-depth research into one of the shortlisted Artes Mundi 10 artists. As a network, and with the rest of the Artes Mundi team, we will find commonalities, shared issues and thematic connections between the shortlisted artist's work and practices, building a wide and generous bank of resources and creative activities for our audiences.

The Engagement Producers will be enthusiastic about culture and ideas which are inspirational, inclusive and creative. We are particularly interested in those with an imaginative and flexible approach to achieving outstanding results. The role requires an ability to engage with audiences and to communicate complex ideas clearly in conversation and through creative acts of making.

You do not need to have any specific qualifications or work experience to be eligible for this role. However, due to the responsibilities and tasks to be undertaken, it is desirable, and we are interested, in hearing from those who have experience through education, previous employment or particular lived experiences such as artists, researchers and creative practitioners from all disciplines, experience and career levels.

Venue Partners and Working Locations

It is a requirement of this role that Engagement Producers can travel to at least one of these venues to undertake work in person. For this reason, we encourage applications from people living in the local area around each of our venue partners.

Duties and responsibilities for events and outputs

These will comprise:

- Writing and recording an audio tour for part of the Artes Mundi exhibition in consultation with curatorial team
- Leading public tours of the exhibition in person and online
- Designing and delivering creative activities or workshops for children and their families

- Designing and delivering a creative activities or workshops for secondary school and/or college groups
- Give feedback about and contribute to the evaluation of the Engagement Producer role and programme

The Engagement Producer opportunities are offered on a freelance basis. However we anticipate that this will equate to approximately 10 days work that must be spread across the duration of the exhibition.

The Person

We want to work with people who:

- Are open, curious and passionate about culture, the arts and communities in Wales
- Are interested in sharing their ideas and are interested in listening to other's
- Enjoy learning new things and taking on challenges
- Can work independently but are comfortable asking for support and guidance

We would be interested to hear from applicants who are Welsh-speakers or are confident speaking, signing and writing in any other languages. Similarly, we are interested in hearing from those applicants who have in-depth knowledge or lived experiences that connect with the thematic ideas and issues inherent within the practices of one of the Artes Mundi 10 artists.

While primarily supported by and responsible to the Curator of Public Programmes, Engagement Producers will have contact with and be supported by the whole Artes Mundi team. As a network and a wider team, we have the skills, knowledge and experience to support each other in creating our programme. For this opportunity we are specifically looking for ambitious ideas and individuals who can demonstrate a strong connection to the work of one of the Artes Mundi shortlisted artists. In addition, desirable knowledge and skills for this role include:

- Experience or understanding of how to work with children and young people
- Experience or understanding of how to work with schools and colleges
- Experience or skill in telling stories or leading tours
- Research skills (reading, watching, listening to, and finding relevant materials)
- Understanding of how to establish and identify connections between international conversations and local context
- Experience of making, writing and/or performing
- Experience of collaborating with other artists and creative people
- Openness and understanding of the editing process when working with others including Curators and Producers

What we will do to support you to do your best work

The Engagement Producers will work closely and collaboratively with the Curator of Public Programmes. You will have regular contact time via online platforms such as Zoom, and when and where possible, in person.

We are committed to providing an environment that nourishes meaningful participation and positive learning experiences. The Curatorial team at Artes Mundi will provide guidance while you are in post and will act as advisors and mentors to you with additional support from the wider team. The advantages of being a small core team will allow you to have regular contact with key members of the artistic leadership including the Director.

Artes Mundi is committed to ensuring equity of opportunity wherever possible and will support with additional access costs that will enable the successful applicants to do their best work. Please contact us directly if there is anything specific you would like to talk to us about.

You will have significant opportunity to grow your confidence and develop your networks with us. You will be given invitations to exhibition openings and creative networking events and opportunities. At the end of this

contract we will assist you to prepare for other opportunities, including support with writing applications, preparing for interviews and providing references to any future employers.

Inclusive Practices

Artes Mundi aims to become a truly inclusive organisation with a workforce and audience whose lived experience is as diverse as the communities it serves. This is fundamental to our future success and ability to continue to contribute to culture and society in Wales and the UK.

Artes Mundi is fully committed to ensuring equality in all our work and we are actively collaborating to create inclusive working cultures. We recognise that there are many people whose experiences and perspectives are not well represented in our work or in the arts sector in Wales. This includes people who are ethnically and culturally diverse; Deaf, disabled and neurodivergent people and people from working class communities. We are especially encouraging applicants who can speak to one or more of these experiences and cultures, including Welsh speakers.

Please note that all interviews will take place online, using Zoom or alternative platforms on request. Further information and instructions will be given to applicants who are invited to an interview. The interview panel will include members of the Artes Mundi team. Financial support is available to anyone who requests assistance that will help them to participate in the interviews online.

Terms of Appointment

This position is offered as a 7-month contract on a freelance basis. An inclusive fee of £1,950 is available for an anticipated 10 days / 75 hours of work, split across 20 weeks from September 2023 – February 2024. Time and dates of delivery to be scheduled and agreed once in post. The post holder will be asked to deliver and undertake work on some evenings and weekends. Appropriate notice will be given.

This post involves working with children and vulnerable adults. Your offer of employment may be subject to a satisfactory disclosure from the Disclosure and Barring Services (DBS). Failure to reveal information relating to any convictions could lead to withdrawal of an offer of employment.






